TRUSTED

Have the respect of the Student Representative Team and are friendly and approachable

RESPECTFUL

Of all students, both within the Student Representative Team and in the broader student body; they listen to and are open to all students

DEMOCRATIC FACILITATORS

Ready to suggest ideas, but know when to step back; willing to respect Student Representative Team decisions even if they don't agree with them

PREPARED

Have and make the time to support the Student Representative Team; bring useful and relevant information to share; can see 'the bigger picture'

ENTHUSIASTIC

Committed to the work and role of the Student Representative Team within the school, and how it can be extended and improved

INFLUENTIAL

Have the confidence and authority within the school community to speak and be heard in support of the Student Representative Team

RESPONSIBLE

Follow through on commitments and what they say they will do
