

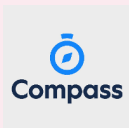


LEARNING FROM HOME: SAFE ONLINE COMMUNICATION

DO ✓

Use school approved communication channels



Stick to communicating within school hours - everyone deserves a break!

Set clear online behaviour expectations for everyone

DON'T ✗

Use social media to communicate



Have one-on-one conversations (unless absolutely necessary for privacy or wellbeing issues)

Expect a teacher to be a counsellor (but they can put you in touch with one)

Wear your pyjamas (unless it's Pyjama Day)
