



# AGREE/DISAGREE/ UNCLEAR

1

Every person writes down three ideas; each one is written in large words on a separate piece of paper.

2

The ideas are all pinned to the wall in front of the group under the heading: **AGREE**. Two other headings: **DISAGREE** and **UNCLEAR** – are also put on the wall.

3

Anyone can shift a piece of paper along the wall to **DISAGREE** or **UNCLEAR**, but no-one can move it back again yet.

4

After everyone has had a chance to shift the ideas or the proposals, the ones under **UNCLEAR** are sorted out: What isn't clear? How could it be written to make it clear? Once it is clear, it is shifted to either **AGREE** or **DISAGREE**. The ones under **DISAGREE** can then be debated

5

Use one of the other techniques to evaluate and prioritise the ideas under **AGREE**.

## PROS

Ideas can be clarified

Allows for anybody to challenge or discuss ideas

## CONS

Time consuming

May become disorderly and confusing

People may be hesitant to challenge others' ideas publicly
